



How to get euros?

- Any ATM

Transport Pass?

The Abono Transporte is a personal and non-transferable pass that allows the user to make an unlimited number of trips in a given space and time. In order to use it, this pass must be charged with the Personal Public Transport Card.

Search in google:

- Abono de transporte / Abono Joven (Youth Pass): until the age of 26.
- 30 days/monthly: valid for all zones with a price reduction to $20 \in$.

How to get it?

- Internet: it can be requested through the official website of the Community of Madrid. The card will be sent by mail to the address indicated in the application in a week or so.
- <u>In-person</u>: it can be applied for at the Public Transport Card Management Offices, requesting an appointment. The card is delivered on the day at the office of the appointment.

Documentation to be submitted

- 1. O<u>nline procedure</u>:
- Indicate your ID card number.
- Upload a passport-size color photo.
- Pay the price of the Transport Card (4 euros).
- 2. <u>In-person procedure</u>:
- Present the application form.
- In this case, it will not be necessary to submit a photograph as it will be done at the office on the day of the appointment.
- Original and photocopy of the identity document (ID card, passport or residence permit).

In short: talk to your buddy or contact a colleague.

It is worth having this card but the procedure can be complicated.








