Universidad Carlos III de Madrid (UC3M) is a public university, innovative and committed to improving society through cutting-edge research and high quality teaching, in accordance with the most stringent international guidelines. It has three undergraduate centers, a School of Postgraduate Studies, and a Doctoral School. It offers 37 Bachelor's Degrees and 13 combined degree courses, of which 78% of the degree courses we offer can be taken either fully in English, or with a bilingual option. It also offers 116 Master Programs and 20 PhD Programs. Created in 1989, it develops its activities in four campuses and has 22.666 students, of which 20% are international students. In addition, it is the first university in Spain and the third in Europe with the largest number of students participating in Erasmus programs; overall, 54% of the students who graduate every year have participated in international mobility programs.

UC3M is included in the QS ranking of the 50 best universities in the world with less than 50 years. Our engineering programs have the EUR-ACE label. We are the first public university to obtain the AACSB accreditation.
