



ERASMUS+ INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY PROGRAMME CALL FOR APPLICATIONS MOBILITY GRANTS FOR BACHELOR STUDENTS AT UNIVERSIDAD CARLOS III DE MADRID 2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Erasmus+ Program aims to improve the quality of Higher Education and to develop its European dimension, by strengthening transnational cooperation between Higher Education Institutions, promoting mobility and improving transparency and academic recognition for skills and qualifications within the European Union.

Student Mobility, included in the Key Action 1 (KA1) of the Erasmus+ Program International Credit Mobility (ICM), is now open to mobility between HEIs in Europe and other Partner Countries around the world.

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ 2020 Call, the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid (UC3M) has obtained funds for students' mobility during the academic year 2022-2023, between UC3M and Non-European Partner Universities.

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

1. Purpose of the Call

Call for mobility stays at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid for bachelor students from the following participating Higher Education Institutions: Ateneo de Manila University (The Philippines), Georgia Institute of Technology (United States), Mapua University (The Philippines), Nanyang Technological University (Singapore), Purdue University (United States), Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (Australia), Singapore Management University (Singapore), Universidad Nacional Autónoma de Nicaragua (Nicaragua), Waterloo University (Canada) and Yonsei University (South Korea).

2. Duration of the stay

The exchange shall take place during the Fall Semester of the academic year 2022-2023.

3. Grants

The selected students will benefit from tuition fee waiver for courses taken at UC3M, notwithstanding other fees for the use of certain services or activities that might be applicable.

The Erasmus+ grant is a contribution to the costs of the planned Erasmus+ mobility period as follows:

^{*}Monthly Subsistence: 850 € /complete month + 1/30 of the monthly allowance for each additional day up to a maximum of 5 months.

The mobility period can be from a minimum of 3 months to a maximum of 5 months. The grant will be paid in case the mobility comprises an onsite stay of a minimum of 3 months.

The grant will also cover the travel assistance insurance expenses corresponding to the general policy offered by UC3M to international and exchange students.

The selected participants are free to make travel and accommodation arrangements that best suit their needs. Important: For booking their flights and accommodation, selected participants need to advance their own funds since the mobility grant will be paid only once their stay begins (see procedures for grants payment in section 8). It is highly advisable to make bookings (flights, accommodation etc.) on conditions that allow full reimbursement in case of cancellation of travel.

Students with special needs: A person with special needs is a potential participant whose individual physical, mental or health-related condition is such that his/her participation in the mobility would not be possible without extra financial support.

To access the grants established in the Erasmus+ Programme for persons with special needs in the field of Higher Education, participants must have a disability legally recognised and qualified to a degree of 33 % or more, as well as complying with the rest of the admissibility criteria established in the Programme, and must apply for such aid through the International Relations Service of the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid.

4. Eligibility Requisites

Applicants must fulfill the following requisites:

- a) To be nominated by the sending University as exchange student within the framework of the Erasmus+ Interinstitutional Agreement signed between UC3M and the partner institutions.
- b) If planned mobility activities will be conducted in a language that is not the native language of the applicant, to have an appropriate level of the language of instruction, B2 being the minimum level. The sending institution will check that the applicant has the required level before being nominated.

- To be enrolled for degree studies in the sending institution at the time of application and also during the mobility.
- d) To submit their complete application within the deadline.

5. Application and Deadline

The sending universities will pre-select the candidates according to the following procedure:

- 1. Nominate the candidates in the traditional UC3M online NOMINATION FORM.
- 2. In Addition, the sending universities will have to send to UC3M, by email to belopezg@pa.uc3m.es, the following information on the nominated candidates that sending universities pre-selected for the grant:
 - Learning Agreement (Annex I) signed by the applicant and the sending institution, scanned signatures are accepted. Candidates should complete only the 1st page of the Learning Agreement.
 - **Motivation Letter** written by the candidate (free format) explaining the reasons to participate in the Erasmus+ Program.
 - The Grade Point Average (GPA) of the bachelor student.

6. Selection Process and Evaluation Criteria

The selection process of the grant beneficiaries will be based on the principles of equity, fairness and transparency among those candidates nominated and pre-selected by the sending universities and shall be carried out by the UC3M Evaluation Committee, which shall consist of:

- Vice-Rector for Internationalisation and European University at UC3M (or the person delegated by same), who will act as President
- Director of the International Relations Service at UC3M, who will act as Secretary
- Head of Non-European Mobility at UC3M
- Erasmus+ KA107 ICM Coordinator at UC3M

The Committee will take into account the following criteria and scales to award the grants:

- Grade Point Average (GPA): 80% of the total score
- Motivation letter: 20% of the total score

The Vice-Rector for Internationalisation and European University will award the grants in the light of the proposal made by the Evaluation Committee, which will also establish a waiting list of candidates who are not awarded the grant.

The number of available grants established in section 3 is a minimum that will be awarded. Depending on the availability of credit, further grants may be generated or extensions may be

granted. In the case that new grants are generated, candidates will be called from the reserve list resulting from the selection process described above.

Grant Acceptance: the grant beneficiaries must accept the grant by e-mail to belopezg@pa.uc3m.es with the subject "Acceptance Erasmus+ ICM 2022", within 7 calendar days of the publication of the award resolution. Failure to accept will be understood as a waiver of the grant awarded, which will be assigned to the next student according to the waiting list, and so on.

7. Obligations of the Beneficiaries

Acceptance of the grant by the beneficiary implies compliance with the rules laid down in this call for applications, and in particular:

- Carrying out the stay on the dates established in section 2 of this Call for Applications.
- Signing the Erasmus+ Program documents: Learning Agreement, Grant Agreement.
- Completing the EU Survey which will be sent 30 days before the end of the stay at UC3M.
- Complying with any other obligations inherent to the Erasmus+ ICM Program and the internal rules of the sending and the receiving institution.

8. Grant Payment Procedure

The final amount of the grants will be calculated taking into account the duration of the real mobility within the official semester period at UC3M.

Upon their arrival to Spain, the student needs to open a Spanish bank account, where the grant will be paid via a bank transfer. The first instalment of 80% of the total grant will be paid once the student has registered at the host university, signed the Grant Agreement and received the certificate of arrival. The second instalment of 20% of the total grant will be paid at the end of the mobility when the student has completed the online EU survey based on the real duration of the stay.

9. Refund of the Erasmus+ ICM Grant

The sums received shall be repaid in the event of failure to comply with any of the obligations laid down in this Call for Applications, except in cases of force majeure.

10. Academic Recognition

Credits earned by each beneficiary at UC3M will be recognized at the sending institution according to the Study Plan proposed by the student and approved by the academic advisor and reflected in the Learning Agreement that must be signed before the mobility starts.

If the beneficiary waives his/her place without good cause before finishing the entire stay, the courses taken at UC3M up to the date of the waiver may be left without academic recognition.
