Modality of participation, application and registration

1. Mode of participation: resident, 15 places. Non-resident, 7 places. Resident mode covers: full board accommodation, accident insurance, trips and excursions, material and documentation required for the development of practices, commemorative t-shirt, certificate of attendance. The non-resident category includes: accident insurance, trips and excursions, material and documentation required for the course, commemorative t-shirt and certificate of attendance. In both categories, it is compulsory to attend at least 80% of the hours, including theory, practices, and visits.

The two modalities of participation will have a pre-selection based on the following criteria:

- Order of arrival of the inscription.
- Curriculum vitae, with particular attention to training in archaeology.

2. Pre-registration and registration:

Due to the reduced number of places, it is necessary to make the pre-registration to the course by completing the attached bulletin and sending it by e-mail (cursodeveranofuentealamo@gmail.com). Once submitted requests and completed the pre-registration period the Organization shall communicate the results of the selection immediately to applicants. Those selected must come to the entry of the registration in the bank account provided with a copy of the transfer. They will lose their rights if the application does not arrive on time. It will also be established a waiting list for possible resignations. The Organization reserves the right to cancel the course if the intended applications minimum is not reached

Establishing a period of pre-registration for two shifts, between May 20 and June 17 (both inclusive).

- Selection of participants of the 1st shift, June 18;
- Income deadline of registration corresponding to the 1st shift: until June 24.
- Selection of participants 2nd shift, on June 20.
- Income corresponding to the 2nd round registration period: until July 1.

PRACTICES OF ARQUEOLOGY AT ROMAN VILLA OF FUENTE ÁLAMO – Puente Genil (Córdoba) (SPAIN)

Objetive

The main objective is the realization of field archaeological practices which contribute to the theoretical and practical training of the participants.

Two shifts

1st shift: 1 to July 20. 2nd shift: from July 26 to August 14.1er turno: del 1 al 20 de Julio. **2º turno:** del 26 de Julio al 14 de Agosto.

Participants

Students and/or graduates of Bachelor's degree or degree of history, art history, humanities and archaeology, interested in completing their education, from national and International University entities.

Venue

Roman villa of Fuente Álamo and facilities for visitors to the site. (Highway CO - 6224, km. 3) (Puente Genil – Córdoba – Andalusia - Spain)

It is a settlement with a timeline ranging from the 1st century to the twelfth of our era. The Roman Villa of Fuente Álamo possesses one of the most important mosaics of Spain and is an example of this type of paradigmatic rural buildings.

Program

With a fully participatory aim, registrants will receive theoretical and practical training in accordance with the following program:

- Learning from field work in Archaeology: methodology, techniques of excavation and archaeological record and interpretation of results.
- Learning documentation and registration in Archaeology: registration cards, inventory, notions of topography for archaeologists, archaeological drawing materials and structures.
- Introduction to the conservation of mosaics and archaeological structures.
- Management of an archaeological site: start value and interpretation of archaeological heritage, cultural tourism.

Hands-on activities

- "Pars urbana" excavation of the Villa: antechambers and cubicula of the residential area, room of representation and transit around the peristyle area.
- "Rustic pars" excavation of the Villa
- Excavation of spaces in the Roman baths.

Theoretical activities

- *Archaeology of the Roman household spaces: historiography and methodological trends.* Dr. Jesús Bermejo Tirado.

- *Roman ceramics as a tool for analysis of the archaeological record.* Sonia Vargas Cantos and Liliana Hernandez Lozano. Archaeologists.
- *Preventive conservation at archaeological sites.* José Montesinos Moreno and Carlos Herrería Gómez, Conservadores-Restauradores of Cultural Property.
