

UC3M4Safety Database - WEMAC

EULA (End User License Agreement)

By signing this document, the user, he, or she who will make use of the dataset, agrees to the following terms.

1. Commercial use

The user may only use the dataset for research. The user may not use the database for any commercial purposes.

2. Distribution

The European Union's General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 regulates personal data processing. Among the principles that should govern the processing of personal data are loyalty and transparency with data subjects (Article 5.1.a)), the limitation of the purpose (Article 5.1 b)), and the minimization of the treatment (Article 25). The user may not distribute the dataset or portions thereof in any way, except for using small portions of data to clarify academic publications or presentations.

3. Access

The user may only use the dataset after this EULA has been signed and returned to the dataset administrators. The user must fill out and sign the EULA, and then send it by email (preferably in pdf format). Please send the scanned EULA to uc3m4safety@uc3m.es.

4. Publications

Publications include not only papers but also presentations for conferences or educational purposes.

The UC3M4Safety Database - WEMAC dataset administrators reserve the right to change this EULA at any time; users will be informed about changes beforehand and given the choice to opt out of the new EULA. Opting out will render the previous EULA void (and thus the user will lose their right to use the dataset).

6. Warranty

The dataset comes without any warranty, the UC3M4Safety Database - WEMAC dataset administrators cannot be held accountable for any damage (physical, financial, or otherwise) caused by the use of the database.

7. Limitations

Any data/datasets provided to user under this Agreement will be de-identified. Data user agrees that data user will not attempt to identify or re-identify any individual patient or group of patients from the data / datasets.
