FROM THE AIRPORT

Take the metro line 8 to NUEVOS MINISTERIOS. Change there to the commuter train line (train called "Cercanías"), and take the train in the direction of Parla station (line C4). Get off at the **LAS MARGARITAS / UNIVERSIDAD** station.

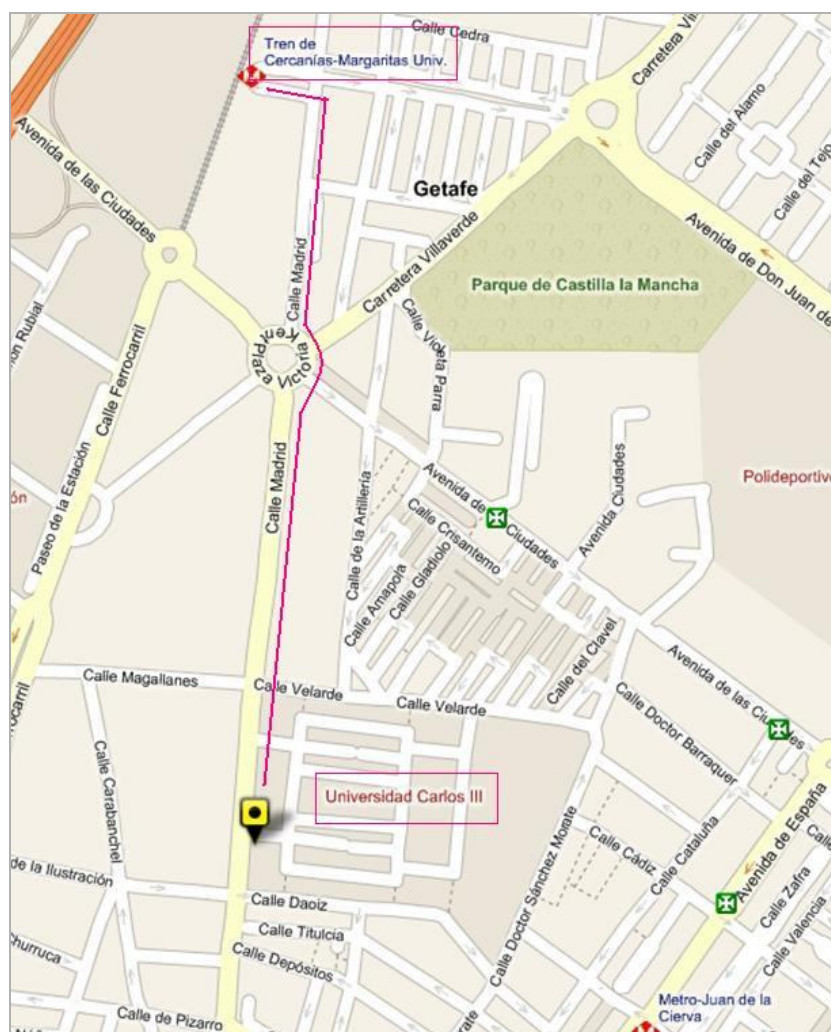
We recommend not taking ONLY metro to get to the university, changing to Cercanías train will save a lot of time.

FROM THE CENTRE OF MADRID

The quickest way is to take the commuter train ("Cercanías") in SOL station or in ATOCHA station in the direction of Parla (line C4). In both cases get off at the **LAS MARGARITAS / UNIVERSIDAD** station.

WALKING TO THE UNIVERSITY

Upon leaving **LAS MARGARITAS** station from the main exit, turn right and walk straight on for 5 or 10 minutes until you reach the University campus.
