Dear students,

As a part of the **vaccination campaign promoted by the Regional Government of Madrid** especially oriented to both Spanish and international university students, mobile units will be located on UC3M campuses:

- Getafe Campus (building 17, ground level).
- Leganés Campus (Auditorium, multipurpose room, ground level).

At both locations you will be able to start or complete your vaccination schedule without prior appointment, presenting an identification document to properly register the vaccination (ID card, Health card, NIE, Passport for international students).

In the case that:

you have received the first dose and you have exceeded the mandatory period between doses, you must provide the document certifying that first vaccination.

you have passed the COVID-19, allow one month after the infection (provided you are recovered), both to receive the first dose and to receive the second dose.

The vaccination facilities will be available on **September 21, 22 and 23 from 10:00** am to 6:00 pm.

After three weeks, these mobile units will be available again to dispense the second dose.

We have also requested the Colmenarejo Campus to be a vaccination point, we are awaiting the response and confirmation from the health authorities.
