

TRAINEESHIP OFFER: OECD STATISTICS ON SUPPORT FOR THE SDGs

The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) is a global economic forum working with 36 member countries and more than 100 emerging and developing economies to make better policies for better lives. Our mission is to promote policies that will improve the economic and social well-being of people around the world. The Organisation provides a unique forum in which governments work together to share experiences on what drives economic, social and environmental change, seeking solutions to common problems.

The Development Co-operation Directorate (DCD) supports the Development Assistance Committee (DAC), contributing to developing better policies for better lives through transparent data on development finance, and improved development co-operation practices and policies.

The DCD is looking for full-time trainees to support the team working on statistics on financing for sustainable development. This traineeship is a great opportunity for students who are in the mid-stage of their studies (e.g. last year of Bachelor's degree), interested in international development statistics, data standardisation processes and visualisation of statistical trends.

Traineeship description

The selected candidate will:

- Contribute to the processing of data (including standardisation and quality assurance) reported to the OECD DAC by multilateral development organisations and private philanthropic foundations, primarily using MS Excel;
- Conduct research and analysis on various resource flows to developing countries (e.g. official development finance and private philanthropy);
- Contribute to OECD publications on development finance;
- Participate in relevant OECD meetings and events.

The internship will take four months as a minimum, starting ideally on 29 August 2022. The selected candidate will receive a remuneration fee of 738 EUR per month on a full time basis. The traineeship will take place in Paris/Boulogne-Billancourt, France.

Ideal candidate

The ideal candidate is a student with a clear affinity with data and statistical evidence in a final stage of his/her Bachelor's degree studies in a relevant field, including economics, econometrics, statistics or similar. Fluency in English is required with working level in French considered an advantage. Proficiency with MS Suite (MS Excel in particular) is required. Experience from multi-cultural settings will be considered an advantage. *Importantly, only students officially enrolled in a study programme of an officially accredited university are eligible for OECD traineeships.*

Application procedure
