#### Language requirements

- ❖ All incoming exchange students need adequate language skills. We require Bachelor students: B2 on the CEFR scale/ ALTE Level 3, in the relevant language, English or German.
- ❖ Master students of the Science in Engineering programme: C1 on the CERF scale, English or German

**ECTS credits**

Per semester a maximum of 30 ECTS can be achieved  
1 full academic year: 60 ECTS  
Complete bachelor's degree: 180 ECTS



\*1 ECTS = 30 hours of workload
