Language requirements For all incoming exchange students we require CEFR level B2 / ALTE Level 3 in the relevant language, English or German.

Grading System In the Swiss system, marks are graded from 6 (best) to 1, with 4 being the minimum score required to pass:

Nomination deadline: April 15, 2022
Application deadline: May 15, 2022

Spring semester 2023: 20.2.2023 - 15.7.2023 (including exams)
Nomination deadline: October 1, 2022
Application deadline: October 15, 2022

Decision on the admission of nominated students will be send one month after the application deadline.
