Housing	The "Kölner Studierendenwerk" offers student housing in different quarters of Cologne. The rent varies according to the size and the location of the room between 210 and 400 euros.

	Students may also arrange housing on their own. The rent is usually higher than the rent of the students housing.		
Food	On the campus, students can find different canteens offering hot meals for lunch and dinner as well as salad bars or snacks. The price for one meal is between 2,30 – 4,50 euros.		
Transportation	The Students Identity Card of the University of Cologne includes a bus and train ticket for the city of Cologne and the whole region North Rhine-Westphalia during the semester term. It is contained within the semester fee which students have to pay obligatory.
