Language of instruction	Most courses are taught in German , only very few lectures and seminars are taught in English or other languages. There are no additional courses for exchange students.	



Language Courses	The University of Münster offers Intensive German Language Courses for exchange students at the beginning of each semester and a large variety of German language courses during the semester. Semester contribution (mandatory)	Each student has to pay the semester contribution fee of approx. € 345 per semester. The contribution includes a public transport ticket for busses and regional trains within Münster and all of North Rhine-Westphalia.
Student housing	The University of Münster is not a campus university and does not offer accommodation to students. The housing situation in Münster is very tense and students should search for housing right after their nomination. Exchange students can apply for a room with the “ Studierendenwerk ”, a public provider that offers rooms for students only.
