| Estimated budget | Average budget: around $600 \sim 700$ euros/month for living <br> expenses (food \& single room accommodation...) |
| Health insurance (compulsory) | > For European students: European Health Insurance Card <br> (EHIC) <br> $>$ For non-European students: Health care expenses can be <br> reimbursed by the French Social Security system. <br> Students must register here (free of charge): <br> https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/\#/ |
| Complementary insurance | To be covered at least the first 2 months of their stay in France, <br> we highly recommend students to purchase a private health <br> insurance before leaving their home country. It takes some time <br> to be registered by the French Social Security System. |
| Civil liability (compulsory) | For a higher reimbursement rate, it is highly recommended to <br> take out an additional medical insurance (around 20€/month). |
