Estimated budget	Average budget: around 600 ~ 650 euros/month for living expenses (food & single room accommodation...)
Health insurance (compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ For European students: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) ➤ For non-European students: Health care expenses can be reimbursed by the French Social Security system. Students must register here (free of charge): https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/
Complementary insurance	For a higher reimbursement rate, it is highly recommended to take out an additional medical insurance (around 20€/month).
