Nomination process	<p>Please only nominate students within the existing agreements between your university and Arts et Metiers. Nominations should be sent as soon as possible to admissions@ensam.eu</p> <p>In your nomination email we would appreciate the following information: students' name and day of birth, email address, students' current level of studies, the program they apply for (Engineering double degree, course/project semester, etc.), starting date (spring or fall), teaching language (English or French)</p>
Application process	<p>Once nominated, the students will be informed directly via email about the application procedure at our institution. From here, they can immediately begin the on-line application process. After receiving students' application documents we will process them internally. When final decisions of acceptance are made, admission letters/notifications are sent via email. If hard-copies are needed, please let us know. Admitted students will receive all the necessary information and support before making the move to France. Practical matters such as residence permit, accommodation, insurance, enrolment can be attended to as soon as the admission is confirmed. Passport	<p>All internationals who wish to pass the French customs must have a valid passport or ID document. For EU citizens, an ID card is sufficient. Passports and ID documents must be valid for the duration of your stay.</p>

<p>Visa & Residence permits</p>	<p>EU citizens and those from countries within the Schengen area do not need a visa.</p> <p>If you are from outside this zone, you will need a long stay student visa when staying for over 3 months in France. In this case, please contact the Consulate General of France nearest to you for further information on how to apply and obtain your visa.</p> <p>NOTE: to be able to study in France, you must have a student visa and this must be obtained before arriving in France.</p> <p>EU citizens and those from countries within the Schengen area do not need a resident permit.</p> <p>If you are from outside the EU and Schengen area, please contact your closest Consulate General of France for information on the residence permit.</p> <p>For more information : admissions@ensam.eu</p>

<p>Health insurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Residents of European Union: the European health insurance card valid during the entire period of the mobility - Quebec residents: the form RAMQ n° SE 401-Q-106 - If you are not concerned by the two previous situations, you will have to subscribe to the French national health care system (“<i>sécurité sociale</i>”). <p>Emergency medical evacuation is not covered by the French <i>sécurité sociale</i>. It is strongly recommended to take out repatriation insurance.</p>
