APPLICATION

Application deadlines

- 1st term: May 31
- 2nd term: October 31

Application procedure

- Partner universities formally nominate their students to UVSQ by email: <u>etudiantetranger@uvsq.fr</u>
- Nominated students then complete UVSQ's online application (the link will be sent individually after nominations).

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

- One orientation day at least at the beginning of each term.

Requirements and tuition fees

- A French language certificate is not required but a B2 level is highly recommended (C1 for French literature) except for courses taught in English.
- No tuition fees, but all students must present a civil liability insurance. This insurance costs approximately 30 € and must be bought in France. EU-students must have the European health insurance card. Non EU-students can register under the French social security (it is free) at their arrival. However, it is recommend to take out private insurance to be covered while your file is being processed by French social security.

HOUSING

Deadlines to apply for room in halls 1st term: May 31 2nd term: October 31

Average cost: 350 to 550 €/month in dormitories 400 to 600 €/month in the private sector

COURSES

- Law and political science.
- Sciences: biology, chemistry, computer science, physics, mathematics, engineering, environmental engineering.
- Social Sciences and Humanities: economics, management, administration, sociology, history, geography, literature and civilisation (French, Spanish and English).
- French as a foreign language: 2 courses offered per level.
- Courses taught in English: American and English Litterature and Civilisation, some International and Political Studies courses.

Please note

- Odd semesters (1, 3, 5) are scheduled in Autumn and even semesters (2, 4, 6) in Spring.
- Students are required to choose a Major field of study but are free to take courses in other fields.
- Vocational licences and masters (licences et masters en apprentissage) and Music theory licence (Licence de musicologie) are not open to students in exchange program.

For courses of second year of Master, students have to contact the relevant teacher prior to arrival to get permission to attend such courses.
