Nomination deadline	Spring semester (January-June): <b>1 October</b> Autumn semester (August-January): <b>1 April</b> Master programs: <b>15 February</b> (Academic year starts in August)
Application deadline	Spring semester (January-June): <b>15 October</b> Autumn semester (August-January): <b>15 April</b> Master programs: <b>1 March</b>
Application formalities	Once the student has been nominated and the nomination is confirmed by the International Office at Karlstad University, an e-mail is sent to the student with instructions for the application procedure. We only accept online applications. Within the application the student will apply for courses and upload requested documents. Please note: late or incomplete applications are not accepted and we cannot make exceptions regarding the application degdline
Accommodation	we cannot make exceptions regarding the application deadline. Karlstad University help all exchange students with accommodation.
Accommodation	All rooms are furnished and have their own toilet and shower. Shared kitchen is standard. All nominated students will receive further information following the nomination deadline.

Learning Agreement	Only for Erasmus+ and ICM students. Can be signed by us <i>after</i> students have received their letter of admission with the courses they are admitted to. Learning Agreements must be complete and signed by home university representative.
Admission fees	No fees for exchange students.
Transcript of Records	When the students have finished their studies at Karlstad University they can request a Transcript of Records. Official documents are not sent by post but instead printed by the students themselves from their personal page on our website. The authenticity of these documents can be checked by following a link on the transcript. If a partner still requires a hard copy these can be ordered from our Welcome Center <u>valkomstcenter@kau.se</u> . All students get information about this before leaving.
	Please note that only Swedish grades are given to students. Karlstad University does not convert grades into other grading scales.
Language courses	Courses in Swedish as a foreign language are usually offered. Grades and credits are awarded for these courses as for other courses at the university.
