Campuses at Tampere University

Tampere University has three campuses located in Tampere. The **city centre campus** is a hub for education, business and management studies, politics, communication, and social sciences. **Hervanta campus** and the surrounding area constitute a major technology hub and serves as the main base for natural sciences, engineering, architecture and health technology. Kauppi campus, located near Tampere University Hospital, is dedicated to medicine, life sciences and health sciences. Language requirements

The required level of knowledge of English is **B2**, however, English language studies organised by the Faculty of Information Technology and Communication Sciences (ITC) are primarily for exchange students nominated for English language and the required level of English is **C1**. English-taught courses and restrictions

Tampere University offers a variety of study options for incoming exchange students. Applicants must submit a preliminary study plan based on the courses offered at the university, ensuring the study field is related to their background at their home institution. Students can also choose courses across different faculties if they meet the prerequisites. However, access to certain fields like architecture is restricted to specific mobility agreements. Erasmus+ students should select most of their courses in the subject field stated in the bilateral agreement. For more details, see tuni.fi/tau-exchange.
