Pre-sessional English (if applicable)	Students with IELTS 5.5 may be eligible for English courses (fees apply)

## Health Insurance Information

<b>One-semester in UK</b>	Private medical health insurance required EU students: can use their EHIC card for emergency treatment
<b>Two semesters in UK</b>	Students will pay International Health Surcharge (IHS) as part of their visa application. They will then be eligible to receive UK National Health Service (NHS) treatment

## Visas

<b>One-semester in UK</b>	EU, US, Canada, Australia, Korea, Japan passport holders: ETA required before travel Other passport holders: Standard Visitor Visa required
<b>Two semesters in UK</b>	All passports: Study Visa required

## Bangor Accommodation

Full year (2x semester) students	Campus accommodation is offered: single ensuite study bedrooms with shared kitchen & social area. Includes all utility bills, gym membership and social events. Approximate cost: Full year: £6875 - £7000
1-semester only students	Campus accommodation can be applied for one a first come first served basis. Support is offered in finding off-campus housing.
