- ✓ Academic Reference from home institution

- ✓ Copy of passport (bio-metric page)
- ✓ English test scores (where applicable)

Entry requirements & English Language

- ✓ First year of study completed
- ✓ Good standing with home institution
- ✓ Full and complete application and supporting documents
- ✓ Minimum GPA 2.75 (or country equivalent)
- ✓ For Full year T4 visa students: IELTS: 5.5 (no individual element below 5.5) or other acceptable English tests (found on https://www.edgehill.ac.uk/international/entry-requirements/english-language-requirements/)
- ✓ For 1 semester students: must be able to study fully in English and have already studied at university level in English

Accommodation

✓ All study abroad and exchange students are guaranteed a single room on campus (*with a meal package*). Fee information can be requested from Edge Hill's International Office.

Visa Requirements

- ✓ Short-Term Visitor Visa is required for students who will be studying at Edge Hill University for 6 months
 or less
- ✓ A **Study Visa** is required for students who will study at Edge Hill University for a Full Academic Year Offer Letters and CAS Statements are produced by the International Admissions team and sent directly to the students' email address.
