Application information

- ✓ **All incoming exchange students should be nominated by their home institution to studyabroad@edgehill.ac.uk by the deadlines listed.**
- *Partner universities in North America do not need to nominate students*
- ✓ Once nominated, students will be emailed with the next steps and a link to the application form. Their home institution will also be copied in.
- ✓ North American partner universities can send the application form to their students directly.

- ✓ Transcript of Studies (*translated if not in English*)
- ✓ Academic Reference from home institution
- ✓ 250–300 words Personal Statement (*Explaining why you want to study at Edge Hill University and what you expect to gain*)
- ✓ Copy of passport (bio-metric page)
- ✓ English test scores (*where applicable*)
- *All supporting documents must be emailed to: internationaladmissions@edgehill.ac.uk*

Entry requirements & English Language

- ✓ First year of study completed
- ✓ Good standing with home institution
- ✓ Full and complete application and supporting documents
- ✓ **Minimum GPA 2.75 (or country equivalent)**
- ✓ **For Full year T4 visa students: IELTS: 5.5 (no individual element below 5.5)** or other acceptable English tests (*found on <https://www.edgehill.ac.uk/international/entry-requirements/english-language-requirements/>*)
- ✓ **For 1 semester students:** must be able to study fully in English and have already studied at university level in English
- *The Study Abroad programme is taught fully in English.*
- **All applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis and circumstances which may have affected a student's GPA will be taken into consideration*

Accommodation

- ✓ All study abroad and exchange students are guaranteed a single room on campus (*with a meal package*). Fee information can be requested from Edge Hill's International Office.

**Successful applicants will be informed of accommodation once their applications have been accepted.*

Visa Requirements

- ✓ **Short-Term Visitor Visa** is required for students who will be studying at Edge Hill University for 6 months or less
 - ✓ A **Study Visa** is required for students who will study at Edge Hill University for a Full Academic Year
- Offer Letters and CAS Statements are produced by the International Admissions team and sent directly to the students' email address.*
