## **About GCU**

Glasgow Caledonian University is located in the heart of Glasgow, a vibrant and cosmopolitan city in the west of Scotland. Students can study courses in the field of business, health & life science, and engineering.

## **Nomination Procedure**

Partner Universities should submit nominations to GCU via the online form.

## **Nomination Deadlines:**

Tri A or full-year: 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023
 Tri B: 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023

Once the nomination deadline has passed, we will contact the student directly with details on how to apply (cc'ing in partner contacts to this communication).

As part of the application students must also submit electronic copies of their:

- Official Transcript noting the home institution's official name, dated within the previous 12 months, and in the English language.
- Copy of an active passport (we cannot accept ID cards)
- English language qualification if not a native speaker:

- Academic IELTS Average Score of 6, with no element less than 5.5
- TOEFL internet-based test overall score of 78 with minimum element scores of reading at 18, listening at 17, speaking at 20 and writing at 17
- Pearson PTE Academic overall score of 54 with no element less than 51
- Cambridge Advanced English (CAE) with a minimum Grade C
- o Trinity College London Integrated Skills in English (ISE) Pass at Level III
- LanguageCert International ESOL- B2 Communicator
  Pass in all four elements
- Where a student is joining GCU for 6 months or less and does not have one of the above English qualifications, we can accept a supporting letter from the home university confirming the English language skills of the student.

## **Application Deadlines**

Trimester A/Full year: 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023
 Trimester B - 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023

Incomplete applications will not be processed.

#### **Modules**

Exchange students may select modules from a dedicated list which will be sent with application information. Module descriptors can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.

All undergraduate GCU modules are 20 SCOTCAT credits which is equivalent to 10 ECTS credits.

 1 trimester: 3 modules = 60 SCOTCAT credits/30 ECTS credits  1 year: 6 modules = 120 SCOTCAT credits/60 ECTS credits

## **Visas**

GCU has a Visa Immigration Support and Advice Team (V.I.S.A) who provide support and advice for all international students.

Upon successful application, students will receive visa advice specific to their individual situation, in addition to a supporting letter to aid entry into the UK for the purposes of study.
