Each module is worth 7,5 ECTS credits and a normal study load is 30 ECTS per semester.

2. FULL SEMESTER, BLOCK EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Alternatively, you may sign up for a full semester within our International Business or Communication bachelor degree programs. Or one of the specialization semesters. The academic program is offered once or twice a year in a block during a semester. You study with Dutch & international degree seeking students.

Note: it is not possible to combine courses from the different levels and programs.
