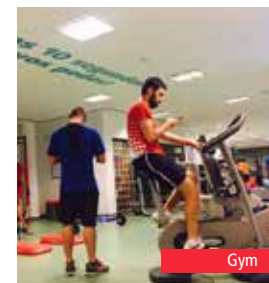

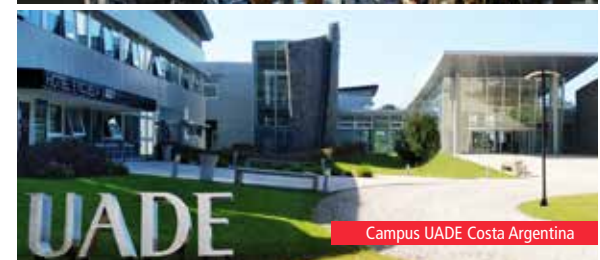

Health Insurance	To be accepted at UADE it is compulsory for all exchange students to get the Health Insurance accepted by UADE. It costs around 257 USD for the whole semester. The service is valid from the beginning of the semester until the last day of classes. If the students apply for two semesters, they will have to hire it again, on the second semester. This insurance includes the repatriation of mortal remains and the requirements of the Argentine state.																								
Visa procedure and requirements	For exchange students and special programs students who want to study in Argentina for less than 365 days, the process for the student visa needs to be started in the Consular representation of Argentina in the country where they live. The student can start the process once he/she is admitted by UADE. The process is personal. We suggest they contact the Argentine consulate to check all the documents they will be required, so that they can have enough time to prepare them.
