Housing information (Types, Fee, Payment, When and How to apply)	UFF does not offer housing. However, the ICO offers a list of accommodations that previous students have stayed in.
Other compulsory fees for international students	No fees are required by our university. Students will need to pay two fees: one to obtain their student visa and another to obtain a mandatory document named RNM, from Brazil's Federal Police, as per federal regulations.

International Student Insurance Information	The student will need to obtain a health insurance of their choice to register at UFF. Health insurance must be valid within the city of Niterói, in Rio de Janeiro state for their full period of stay. The insurance <u>must</u> cover the COVID-19 disease.
Visa Information	IF ON-CAMPUS MOBILITY A student visa is required. The visa must be obtained BEFORE the student's entrance in Brazil.
	The process may take a few weeks, so begin early. Under NO circumstances should you apply for a tourist visa. They are valid for only 90 days and cannot be extended.
	You must obtain the visa from the Brazilian consulate in your area of jurisdiction and, in some cases, a personal visit to the consulate may be required. You should apply for a visa from the consulate whose area of jurisdiction includes your permanent home.
	If this is not possible or is very inconvenient, you may request that the consulate within the area of jurisdiction of your home institution accept and process your visa application.
Minimum credit for exchange students	No minimum credit, but international mobility students should have concluded at least 1 full year of studies at their home institution.



Other Information	Students must register from 3 (minimum) to 6 (maximum) classes.
	Undergraduate classes are taught in Portuguese, except for the classes in foreign languages registered on UFF's website.
Credits	UFF uses an hourly workload system in place of credits. More information is available at our <u>International</u> <u>website</u> .
Grades	UFF grades are from 0 to 10, with the minimum passing grade being 6. More information is available at our <u>International website</u> .
Class attendance	UFF also evaluates the student according to their class attendance. It's necessary to attend at least 75% of the classes.
Transcript of Records	It will be sent to the student's home institution after their mobility.
