ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time undergraduate or graduate students in an accredited university or equivalent.
- Students who have completed at least one semester at home university with GPA of 2.5/4.0(75/100) or above
- 3 Students with language ability to take courses in either English or Korean

Graduate	 The Graduate School courses are available. Some courses in the Graduate School of International Studies are available. Some English-taught courses of School of Law are available. Courses in the Graduate School of Business courses are available for graduate students only. The Professional Schools, The Special Graduate Schools are not available, except those mentioned above.

HEALTH INSURANCE

It is mandatory for students to obtain health insurance. Students may obtain their insurance at their home country or through Ewha Womans University.

* Cost of Ewha Collective Insurance: 42,000 KRW per semester and 60,000 KRW per year (Fees are subject to change). Additionally, the Ministry of Health and Welfare has implemented mandatory National Health Insurance for international students starting from March 2021. Students will need to obtain all necessary insurance to study in Korea.



HOUSING

Ewha Womans University provides on-campus housing for exchange/visiting students. However, it is designated on a firstcome first-serve basis. Tuberculosis negative result issued within 1 month before the check-in and Certificate of Entry are required for students who have applied for on-campus housing. * subject to change



BUDDY PROGRAM

PEACE BUDDY program is a partnering program for exchange/ visiting students. Exchange/Visiting students will be able to be partnered with Ewha Students and get assistance regarding their exchange at Ewha. Buddy program is not mandatory for students.
