Academic Information

Level of Study

Both Undergraduate and Graduate levels, depending on exchange account balances and admission.

Course Load per Semester

Undergraduate: Minimum 12 credits. Some exchange programs cover more credits.

Graduate: Minimum 9 credit hours. Most courses are 3 credit hours.

Course Registration

Students select & register for courses themselves.

Housing

Housing contracts are 1-year contracts; students are billed per semester. Official per semester cost TBA.

General Application Process

1. University partners submit a list of names.
2. Students receive instructions on how to complete the university's application process and a waiver code for the application fee.
3. Students apply for university housing.
