With 73 years of history and tradition, the College of Education became the largest one among the nation's colleges of education.

It is Korea's best educational institution to train future teachers, having 122 full-time professors and 2,400 students enrolled across 23 departments.

Over the past decade, it has ranked the first in the country in terms of the number who passed the national teacher appointment exam.

It has also achieved great results in outside evaluations, being the sole recipient of consecutive A grades from the 1<sup>st</sup> (1998) to the 5<sup>th</sup> (2020) cycle of the Ministry of Education's teacher training institution evaluations.



#### + Graduate School of Policy Convergence and Public Affairs

Graduate School of Policy Convergence and Public Affairs aims to establish a public policy problemsolving talent convergence platform, capable of upgrading national policy and operates a total of four detailed majors in the fields of future growth policy, sustainability policy, inclusive social policy and state administration.

#### + Graduate School of Techno Convergence

The Graduate School of Techno Convergence aims to adapt to the rapid development of industrial technology and foster local talents who can play a leading role in this development, with the expertise, management knowledge and international sense necessary for global competition. With the master's degree course operated in the evenings on weekdays, after obtaining a degree students can enter a general graduate school doctoral course. Established in March 2009 and currently offering 6 master's degrees, with 180 faculty members in each field and bringing in invited outside instructors, the school provides opportunities for experts or corporate managers in the field of technology to take a new leap forward.
