



The Master in Accounting at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid is a one-year full-time official program designed to provide high quality graduate education in areas such as financial reporting, management accounting, and auditing at the national and international level. The master is taught entirely in English by highly recognized academics and industry experts, and it is aimed at recent graduates and junior professionals who wish to acquire an updated, applied and professional perspective of Accounting and develop their professional or academic career in this area.

As a newly-launched high-quality program, the Master in Accounting has set up academic partnerships with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) and CIMA (Chartered Institute of Management Accountants). The program covers contents consistent with the Strategic Professional exams of the ACCA qualification and with the Management Level exams of the CIMA professional qualification. The programme is also in process of acquiring the partnership with ICAC (Instituto de Contabilidad y Auditoría de Cuentas). Students can tailor the program's curriculum according to their career plans by choosing their preferred elective courses.

The Masterin Accounting is taught at the University's Graduate School, located in Madrid city center's Puerta de Toledo campus. The relative small, yet extremely diverse, group of students in the master, offers an environment that stimulates rigorous, multicultural learning and encourages independent thinking and critical analysis of accounting issues in a complex business environment.



The master is organized in four 7-weeks terms. Students need to take 60 ECTS to obtain the title. The program has 48 ECTS compulsory and 12 ECTS Elective. The elective courses are designed so that students have the option to specialize in financial accounting, management accounting or auditing and opt to prepare for the ACCA, CIMA, or ICAC professional exams.
