Because it is in high demand and fills quickly, we encourage students to apply <b>as early as possible</b>.</p> <p>The online housing application for students starting in September opens in December. The online application for students starting in January opens in May.</p> <p>Students are advised to apply for housing as soon as you have selected them. They do not need an acceptance letter from our office or a UCalgary ID number to apply for housing.</p>
