The maximum grade is 30/30 (30/30 with honours). The credits corresponding to each academic activity is acquired by a student only when he/she passes an exam or another kind of learning evaluation. The Italian grading system is expressed in CFU. 1 CFU corresponds to 1 ECTS.</p>
