### 1. INFOSIL

INFOSIL is the intranet where you can access all your academic information, news, updates and USIL notices, informative documents, course materials, syllabi, notes, class attendance, among others.

### 2. MEDICAL CARE

- International health insurance

One of the requirements to apply to USIL is to have an international insurance that covers medical expenses, accidents, risks and travel-related issues. Before you arrive in Peru, you need to be aware of the following:

- At all times, carry a copy of your International Medical Insurance with you.
- Have a list of medical institutions where you can be seen in case of an emergency. You can get this information through your insurance broker.
- Know the payment process to the medical institution, in case you need to use your insurance.
