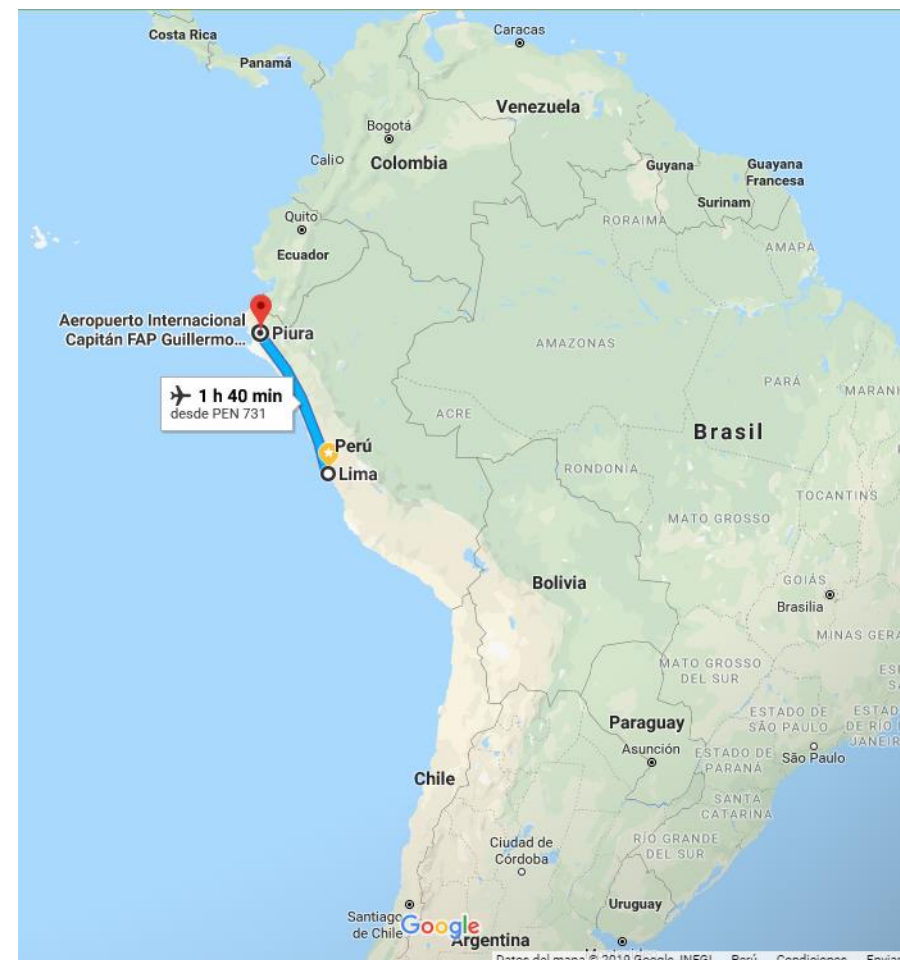

To date, the University has:

- Campus Piura, where it started activities 50 years ago and operates the headquarters, located in the city of Piura, in the north of the country;
- Campus Lima, created in 2003, is currently located in the district of Miraflores; and
- PAD- School of Management, with current headquarters in the district of Surco, also in Lima, which this year celebrates 40 years since it began its activities.
- It has seven faculties: Engineering, Economic and Business Sciences, Law, Communication, Education Sciences, Humanities and the recently created Faculty of Human Medicine. It offers more than 30 undergraduate courses, almost 30 master's degrees and 5 doctorates, in addition to numerous updating and specialization programs, at Campus Piura, Campus Lima and the PAD-School of Management.

(*) The Business Administration Program is offering courses taught **in English** in its campus in Lima. The courses are opened to international and local students for the fall semester 2019. International students can take courses from different levels, and also be enrolled in courses taught in English or Spanish.

(**) Please note that the Medicine program is new and it is not possible to accept exchange students at the moment.

Course Information

Almost all courses during the semester are taught in Spanish. While a specific certificate of proficiency in Spanish is not required, you must have at least an intermediate level (B2) in order to understand the classes and participate in them.

The undergraduate program study plans and course descriptions may be found at our web page. Students may also ask for this information at the International Relations Office.

Not all courses found in the Course Catalog are offered each semester. Students should consult the university timetable in making course selections.





Academic Load

Preliminary lists of courses offered are available around one month prior to the beginning of the semester. Dates and additional information will be provided by the International Relations Office.

Grading system

According to national regulations, the grading system in Peru is vigesimal, zero (0) to twenty (20). This is the system implemented by the University of Piura. However, it should be noted that each university is free to set different criteria and standards. Therefore averages an institution, may be comparatively higher or lower than those of other institutions.

Each course in the curriculum is considered APPROVED, when the average rating is equal to or greater than eleven, 11 (the minimum passing grade). In some cases, the courses are described as approved (A) or validated (C), without a numerical grade.

After finishing the semester, each exchange student will receive an official document, *Transcript of Records*.

The document will be sent to the International Relations Office of the home university.

- **Spanish Certificate** (The Home University can provide a language certificate to the student, which accredits that the student has done at least four-semester's of Spanish or equivalent.)

- Letter in Spanish, introducing to himself/herself and explaining motivations to participate in the exchange
- Clear passport copy
- Copy of international health insurance (mandatory)

4) ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Regular term dates

Semester I / **Spring Semester**: March – July

Semester II / **Fall Semester**: August – December

Important: Our semesters consist of 16 weeks. Out of those, 14 weeks correspond to classes; one week is for the mid-terms and another one for final exams.



Orientation sessions

The registration and orientation day usually takes place around a week prior to the beginning of classes. The International Relations Office may provide details.

In order to attend all required orientation sessions, exchange students should plan to arrive in Perú no later than the morning of the Tuesday prior to the start of classes.



5) COMING TO PERU: WHAT TO KNOW



VISA

International students coming from partner universities can access the **exchange visa**, which does not involve expenses and is processed by UDEP International Relations Office.

Notice that **is important to get this type of visa for a stay longer than 180 days.**

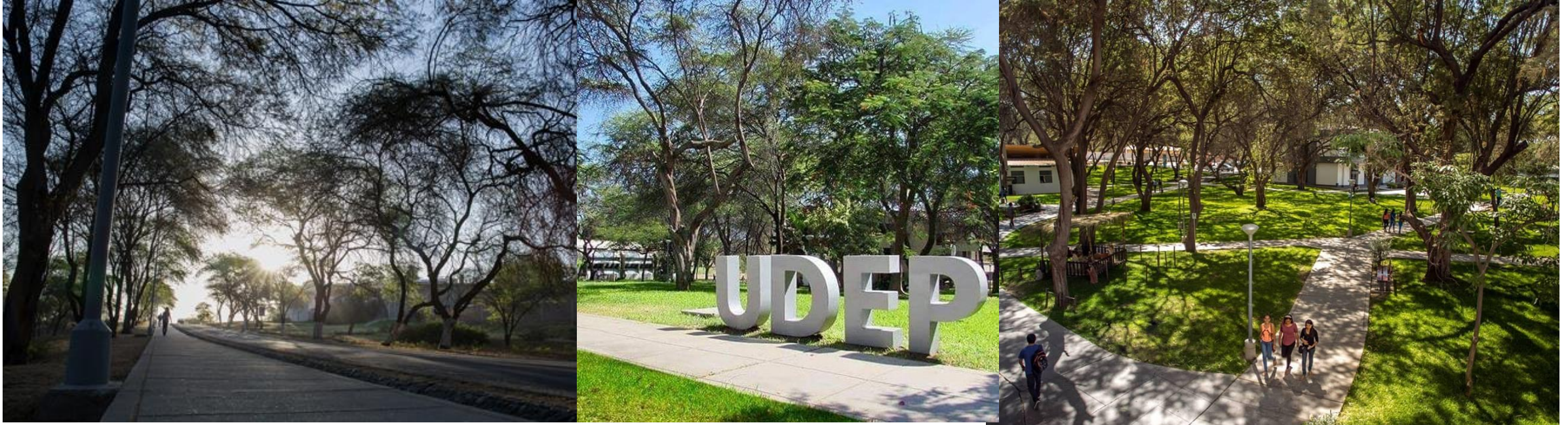
If so, you must complete the form VISA ([clíc here](#)) and submit the following documents:

Can I enter to Peru as a tourist if I have a Schengen passport?

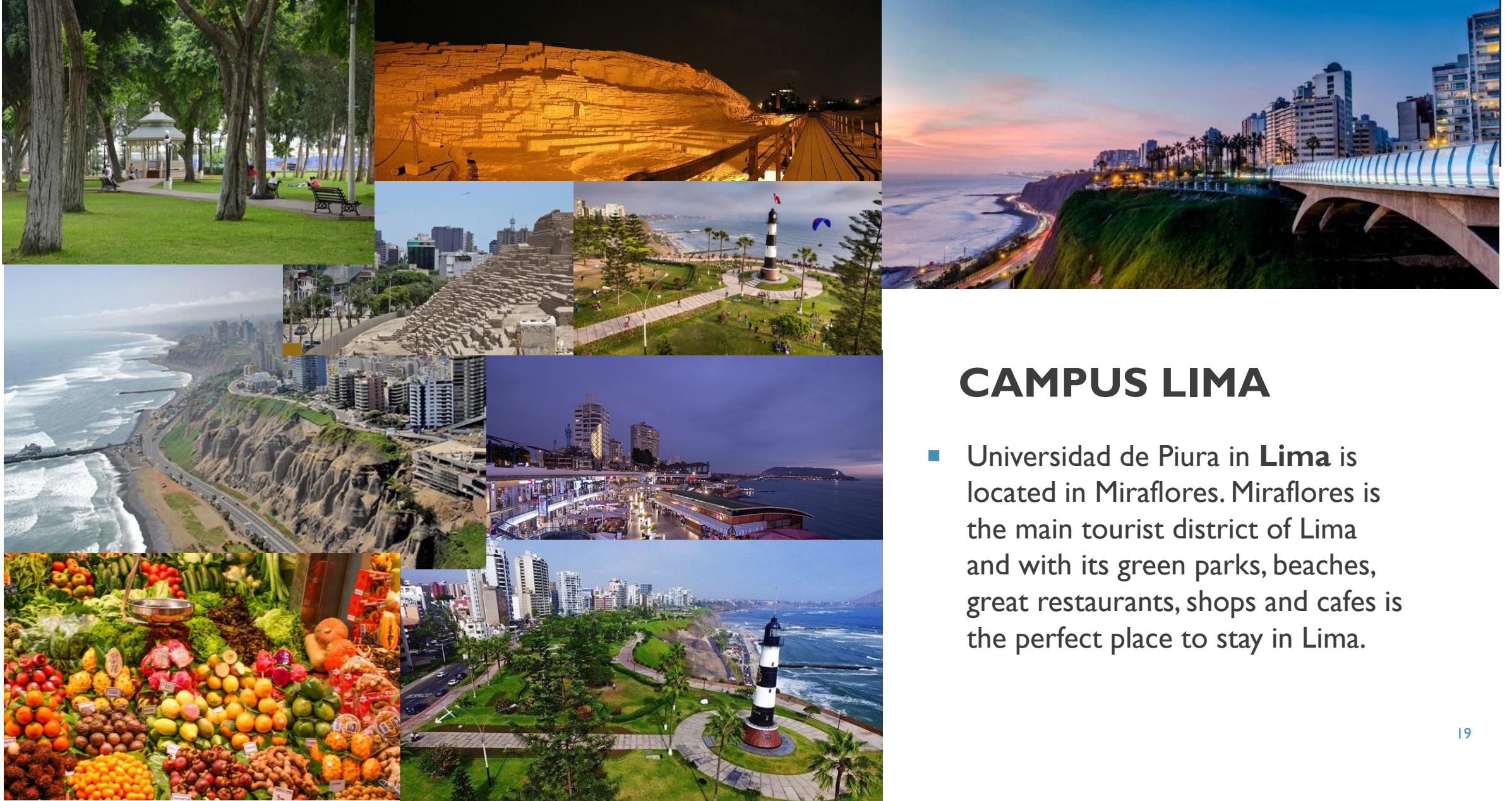
Yes, it is possible, specially if you will travel many times outside Perú. But it is important to know that the best option is that you get 180 days (6 months) as a permission to stay in Perú. Otherwise if you get just 90 days, you will need to extend your visa in Migration Offices or travel outside Perú to get 90 days or more.

CAMPUS PIURA



Universidad de Piura has become a green lung for the city of **Piura**, protects the soil, the flora and fauna of the endemic region of Tumbes and is a model of conservation of the dry forest. In addition, our forest contributes to the reduction of greenhouse gases.

The dry forest of our campus is home to 72 species of birds. Living in contact with nature is part of the UDEP Experience.



CAMPUS LIMA

- Universidad de Piura in **Lima** is located in Miraflores. Miraflores is the main tourist district of Lima and with its green parks, beaches, great restaurants, shops and cafes is the perfect place to stay in Lima.

Housing

Universidad de Piura does not have student dormitories. However, the International Relations Office provides information and assistance to exchange students on how to accommodate in a student house (privately run dorms), live in a family home or rent a flat (apartment) in the city. The International Relations Office has a list of recommended contacts for all these options. Monthly rents are about US\$ 210 to US \$ 380. Prices may vary according the city (Lima – Piura).

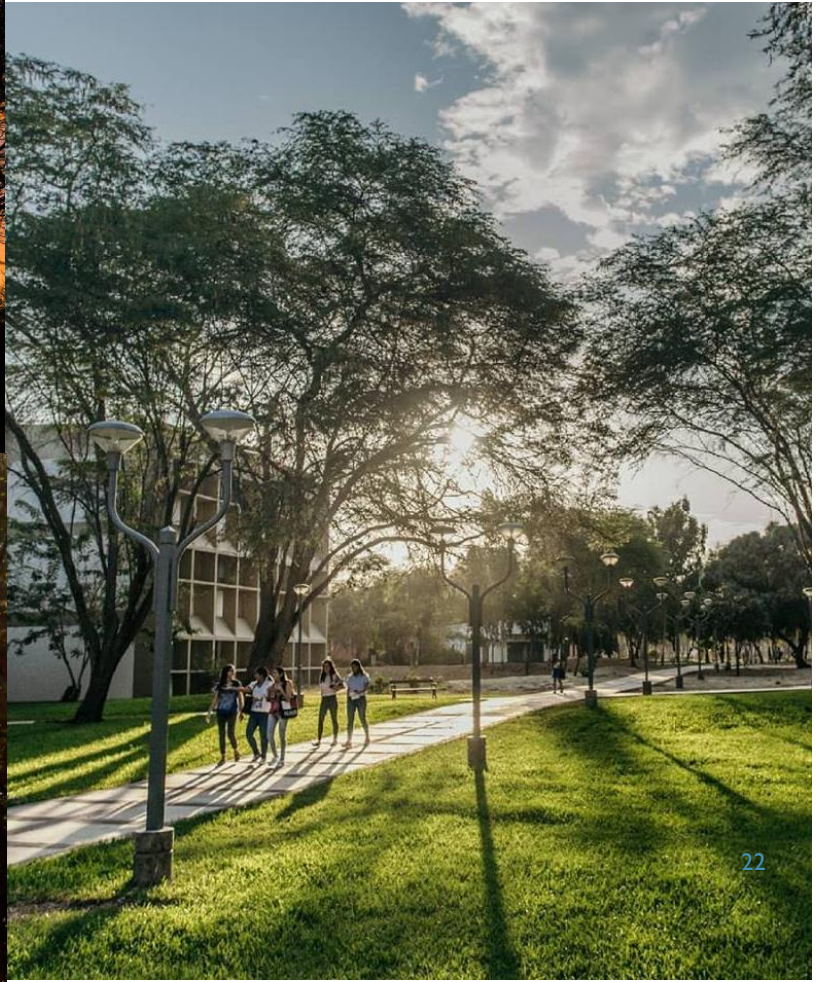


AYNI UDEP is an association of volunteer students who will assure you during your academic stay at our institution.
