



FINANCE:

The finance specialty allows you to focus on one (or more) of three paths, each designed to help you pursue your career interests.

Personal Finance: Learn how to help people achieve their financial goals with financial planning courses that prepare you to write the first of two professional exams leading to the Certified Financial Planner (CFP) designation.

Investment Management: Focus on investment management courses that can lead you towards the Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) designation.

Corporate Finance: Opens opportunities in government, insurance and banking.

ACCOUNTING:

This specialty provides you with a strong set of problem-solving, communication and interpersonal skills, in addition to the accounting and managerial skills for today's complex and evolving business environment.

Key areas of study include financial and managerial accounting, income tax, cost accounting and auditing. Graduating with this specialty opens doors to employment in many segments of the economy, including manufacturing and service industries, public accounting, government and the not-for-profit sector.

Take all the prerequisites courses you need for the Chartered Professional Accountants (CPA) designation.

HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT:

The human resources specialty provides you with knowledge and skills that focus on human behaviour in the workplace.

Key areas of study include recruitment and selection, training and development, compensation and benefits, employment law, health and safety and strategic HR planning.

Graduating with this specialty prepares you to pursue a career as a specialist in a variety of HR fields or a more broadly based HR career.

Our HRM specialty degree program is accredited by Chartered Professionals in Human Resources (CPHR) British Columbia and Yukon.







MANAGEMENT:

Choose from three streams designed to provide theoretical and practical skills for managing organizations, people and your own career.

Entrepreneurial: Learn to prosper as an entrepreneur or manager. Explore entrepreneurial thinking, processes, leadership and strategy.

Supply Chain and Operations:

Become an effective leader and supply chain manager. This stream focuses on operations, manufacturing, purchasing, logistics, leadership and more.

Sustainability: Learn to make self-sustainable business models, incorporate practices that support sound environmental decisions and manage organizations that use socially responsible strategies.

MARKETING:

Today's businesses depend on innovative marketing professionals to effectively plan, create, market and sell products and services. With this specialty, you will learn both theoretical and applied aspects of the marketing process. Key areas of study include market research, digital marketing, consumer behaviour, marketing strategy, integrated marketing communications, e-marketing, services marketing, events marketing, branding, customer relationships and sales.

TOURISM & HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT:

This specialty gives you an understanding of business and management practices within the global tourism and hospitality sector as well as a foundation in general business. You will enhance your analytical and critical thinking skills while learning concepts in sustainability and assessing issues facing the industry.

Graduating with the tourism and hospitality management specialty prepares you for a career leading to management positions within the local and global tourism and hospitality sector.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION DIPLOMA

The Business Administration Diploma provides you with a comprehensive understanding of business practices. Students develop fundamental business skills in their first year. In the second year of the program, students focus on a field of interest. You can choose to graduate with a general business diploma or focus your studies in one of the six areas of study.







COMMERCIAL AVIATION DIPLOMA

Let your future take flight

The Commercial Aviation Diploma is offered in partnership with Southern Interior Flight Centre (SIFC). This two-year program integrates the flight training required by Transport Canada with business administration courses applicable to the aviation industry. The diverse terrain and weather in the Okanagan Valley provides a challenging and unrivalled training environment.

Okanagan College and SIFC continue to strengthen ties with industry partners to create the best possible opportunities for students, such as:

Air Canada Award

The top student each year receives a trophy, along with two return airfare tickets and the ability to add the award to his or her resume when applying at Air Canada

Jazz Aviation Pathways Program (APP)

Jazz APP helps graduating pilots land careers with the national airline, either directly after graduation, or later when application requirements are met. Okanagan College is one of the first aviation schools in Western Canada to offer the APP program.

Office Assistant Certificate

Discover the fundamentals of office administration to start your career as a receptionist or office assistant, or take further courses in order to specialize as an accounting, legal or medical assistant.

Administrative Assistant Certificate

Obtain the skills you need to begin your career as an administrative professional. As a graduate of this program, you will be equipped with the business, communication and technical skills required by today's employers.

Accounting/Bookkeeping Certificate

Learn accounts payable/receivable, payroll and general bookkeeping to prepare you for a career as an accounting assistant or bookkeeper for small, medium or large companies.

Legal Administrative Assistant Certificate

Litigation Specialty and/or Corporate/Conveyancing Specialty

Develop the skills to start your career as a legal administrative assistant in the areas of litigation and/or corporate law. Gain expertise in legal office procedures to begin a career in a legal, government or real estate office.

Medical Administrative Assistant Certificate

Learn the medical terminology, transcription and billing procedures required to start your career as an assistant in a medical clinic, hospital or health office.






