Universidade Federal Fluminense (UFF), founded in 1960, is a public educational institution, linked to the Federal System, situated in the state of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Its headquarters and 3 main campuses are located in the city of Niterói and 8 more campuses are distributed at other cities of Rio de Janeiro state. UFF also has an advanced campus in Oriximiná, in the state of Pará, inside the Amazon Rainforest.

With an estimated population of 500,000 inhabitants, Niterói is only 13 kilometers (8 miles) away from the city of Rio de Janeiro, capital of the state, both located on the Guanabara Bay area and on the coast of the Atlantic Ocean. Niterói is favored by predominantly tropical weather, an outstanding view of the city of Rio de Janeiro, with its mountains and tropical forest, as well as masterpieces created by the famous Brazilian architect Oscar Niemeyer.

UFF ranks among the best universities in Brazil, with approximately 56,000 students in 131 undergraduate programs, in addition to approximately 6,500 Master and Doctorate students attending 80 graduate programs. The undergraduate degree is the first step in the academic development, which is completed by the Masters and Doctorates with strong emphasis on research.
