## Brasilia

Brasilia was built in 41 months and inaugurated on April 21<sup>th</sup> 1960 by President Juscelino Kubitschek.

The planned capital city is listed as World Heritage Site by UNESCO due to its modernist architecture.

Brasilia's population is about 2.8 million. It is the 4<sup>th</sup> most populous city in Brazil.



## The weather of the city

The weather in Brasilia is known as "Cerrado". It is a vast tropical savanna ecoregion of Brazil. The yearly average temperature in Brasilia is 20.5°C (69 °F).

Brasilia has a dry season and a rainy season. The dry season is from May to September. During the dry season, the weather cools down. The coldest month is July, with an average low of 13°C (55°F).

The rainy season lasts from October to April. It is warm and mild. The hottest season in the year is September (26°C or 85°F).

### Free transport card

UnB students can apply for a free transportation card (*Cartão Passe Livre Estudantil*). The student must live at least 2 kilometers from UnB and only use the free transportation service to go to the university.

**Getting your free transport card:** applications are made online at [www.passelivreestudantil.df.gov.br](http://www.passelivreestudantil.df.gov.br)

Click on “Cadastro”. You will need to submit an online copy of your passport, CPF, Federal Police registration, a 3x4cm photo, list of school subjects (Stamped and signed by the Department in charge), proof of address (for the students who live in the campus, present the contract; for students who live in private accommodation, present the contract or a letter from the owner) and a regular student certification.



### University of Brasilia

UnB was founded on April 21<sup>st</sup> 1962, to integrate the city especially built to be the capital of the country.

Created as the 1<sup>st</sup> modern research university in Brazil, the UnB brought a new concept of institution based on autonomy of management, research, teaching and academic structure. It was the first university in Brazil to be divided into Institutes and Faculties. The pedagogical model was designed by educator Anísio Teixeira along with the anthropologist Darcy Ribeiro.



## University of Brasilia

UnB is led by a Rector and a Deputy- Rector who are elected by a universal vote system every four years. There are seven Deans nominated by the Rector responsible for the following administrative duties:

1. Administration and Finance;
2. Undergraduate Studies;
3. Graduated Studies and Research;
4. Personnel Management;
5. Budget and Financial Planning;
6. Extension activities;
7. Social and Community Affairs.



## UnB numbers (2014)

- Over the last 45 years **UnB** has become not only the main center for research and graduate studies in the Middle- West of Brazil, but also one of the most important in the country.

## UnB Facilities

- **Library (BCE):** created in 1962, Central Library (BCE) holds over 1.5 million volumes.
- **University farm (FAL):** With nearly 10,000 acres, it provides education and research opportunities to students of Agricultural, Veterinary, Biology and Environmental sciences.
- **University hospital (HUB) and Veterinary hospital:** HUB was established in 1970. Nowadays it registers more than 149.611 consultations and 5.713 surgeries per year.
- Olympic Center, Language Center, Cafeteria, green areas, Banks, Post office, Stationery shops, Service station, Convenience store, etc, are other facilities that you can find on the campus.

## Academic calendar

### Enrollment Period

Period to confirm the subjects with the academic coordinator at UnB. The student may also change the learning agreement.

Enrollment in Portuguese for Foreigners classes takes place through International Affairs Office (INT).

### Enrollment Adjustment

Deadline to request the adjustments on on classes schedule: change subjects or classes, insert or remove subjects, by means of a formal request through the Academic Coordinator.

## Academic calendar

### Automatic Partial Locking

Partial enrollment lock of the subject can be requested by the student to suspend curricular activities. Partial locking of enrollment, or automatic locking of discipline (TR), can be granted only once in each isolated subject and within the deadline stipulated in academic calendar. Note that it will be marked on your Transcript of Records.



### Portuguese classes

UnB offers Portuguese classes (beginner and intermediate level) for international students. Applications are done at the Office of International Affairs (INT) or submitted to [intweb@unb.br](mailto:intweb@unb.br). Please include on the application your mother tongue and level of knowledge of Portuguese. If you studied Portuguese before, please specify how and where the study was done and duration.

### Accommodation

Small apartments (kitchenette) or Living with co-tenants (República) are usually the most affordable housing option. Kitchenette options near UnB campus are located on 406/407 and 410/411 north. ## How to Apply (Incoming students)

### 2) Check the application requirements:

- To be a regular student at one of UnB's partner institutions;
- To be nominated by the partner institution;
- To have a minimum level of Portuguese to attend the classes at UnB (no specific certificate is required);
- To present a statement of financial support for the whole exchange period.

### 3) Complete your application form:

- Complete your application form, including the study plan (type in Portuguese, English or Spanish). Attach all required documentation.

### 5) Wait for approval:

After your application is received by INT your study plan will be sent to the relevant faculty for approval of the units you have selected.

An admission letter will be delivered by the Office of International Affairs (INT) to the home university of the student.



### How to Apply for a Visa

After receiving the Letter of Acceptance, please contact the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate at your home country in order to request the Student Visa.

### How to enroll at UnB

The student must request a CPF (Federal Revenue Number), which is mandatory to enroll at the UnB.

#### **Requesting your CPF number**

A) In your home country: At the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate for free.

B) In Brasilia: This registry cost R\$7,00. Payments are accepted at any Banco do Brasil, Caixa Economica Federal or Correios agency. Bring your passport and any other document where your parents complete name and surname appears (ex: birth certificate). Then, with your passport and proof of payment go to the Receita Federal do Brasil to get CPF.

### National registry of foreigners (RNE)

In order to get this registry, student must request an appointment at the Federal Police. **Be aware that the appointment must be taken within 30 days from the date of entry on national territory.**

C) Go to <https://servicos.dpf.gov.br/gru/gru?nac=1&rec=2> to emit two payment forms (Guias), corresponding to: foreigner registry (GRU N° 140082, R\$64.58) and foreigner card (GRU N° 140120, R\$204,77). Payments are accepted at any Bank agency.
