International Student Acmission

Undergraduate Students

International Academic Mobility (6 months to 1 year)

Requirements

- Being regularly enrolled in a foreign institution of higher education partnered with UNIFEI;
- Having a valid health insurance plan during their stay in Brazil;
- Having at least basic (survival) Portuguese language skills.

Required Documents

Once the student has met the previous requirements, the partner institution must send SRI the following documents:

- Academic transcript;
- Letters of Recommendation from teachers (optional);
- Letter of Motivation:
- Study plan;
- Passport photocopy;
- Two recent photographs, size 3x4cm;

Undergraduate Students

Student Program - Undergraduate Partnership (PEC-G)

This program is for foreign students whose home countries have a framework agreement with Brazil in education, culture, science or technology areas. To be eligible, the student must be foreign-born and graduated from or coursing the last year of high school, in an international institution outside Brazil. The student must apply in person at the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate in their home country.

It is important to know which Higher Education Institutions (Instituições de Ensino Superior -IES) in Brazil are part of this program and which courses they offer. Vacancies are distributed by the Office of the Provost for Undergraduate Studies (Pró-Reitoria de Graduação - PRG), through a letter sent annually to the Brazilian Ministry of Education (MEC). When applying, the student may choose two course option in each desired city of residence.

Required Documentation for International Students

Visa

A student visa is necessary to enter Brazil. You can apply for a Student Visa at the Brazilian Consulate or Embassy in your home country. If accepted at UNIFEI, either in a mobility program or as a regular student, undergraduate or graduate, the student will receive an acceptance letter from either PRG or the Office of the Provost for Research and Graduate

Studies (Pró-Reitoria de Pesquisa e Pós-Graduação - PRPPG). You must take this letter with you when applying for a student visa.

Please note that a student visa does not allow the practice of paid activity of any kind during the student's stay in Brazil. It is also not possible to change a tourist visa to a student visa.

How to apply for a CIE

Fill out the electronic form available under "Requerer Registro / Renovação" option. Then, click the SALVAR button and print the completed form.

Generate the Guia de Recolhimento da União (GRU), a document similar to a common bank slip

Foreign Resident's Identity Card (Cédula de Identidade de Estrangeiro - CIE)

The CIE is a foreign resident's main document. To apply for a CIE, the student must be registered at the Federal Police's immigration office within 30 days of arrival in Brazil; otherwise, the student will be fined for each late day. This document can only be required in person, at the Federal Police Office closest to their place of residence. Once registered, the CIE (pictured) will be issued, identifying the student's residency status and period of stay.



Documents required to apply for a CIE

- Registration application form, completely filled and printed;
- Valid travel document (ID is accepted for Argentina, Uruguay, Paraguay, Chile, Bolivia, Peru, Colombia and Ecuador), original and authenticated photocopies of the used pages of the passport or travel document;

International Academic Mobility Student (6months 1 year)

The foreign student's initial enrollment is done through the Integrated Academic Activities Management System (Sistema Integrado de Gestão de Atividades Acadêmicas - SIGAA), by the Board of Academic Registry (Diretoria de Registro Acadêmico - DRA).

For the initial enrollment, the student must bring the following documents:

Regular PEC-G Student

The foreign student's initial enrollment is done through SIGAA, by the Board of Academic Registry. The applicant must bring:

After receiving your student ID number, please access Unifei's Academic System (SIGAA) in order to register in the desired subjetcs, following your program's academic calendar. If this is your first access to SIGAA, please use the option "cadastre-se" to sign-up.

In Itajubá

Foreign students usually choose to live in a student house (República Estudantil). A República is house or apartment shared by a small amount of students, usually from the same program or institution.

By choosing this housing option, the student gains independence, learns to live with different people and develops personal responsibility by executing in-house tasks and/or paying household expenses.

Further advantages of living in a república include daily interaction with students from several different Brazilian areas, possibly developing great friendships, possibility of practicing the Portuguese language and learning more about the Brazilian culture.

Living expenses in a república will depend on the amount of students living a house. In a fourstudent house, for example, costs are usually around R\$500.00.

In Itabira

Repúblicas are also a housing option for foreign students in Itabira. Living expenses usually cost around R\$500 a month, depending on the amount of students in a house and other variables, such as individual rooms, food options, among others.

Other housing options include renting a room in a family house, hotel or inn, or renting a flat.

Public Healthcare System SUS Sistema Único de Saúde

In Brazil, the Sistema Único de Saúde (Unified Health System, or SUS for short) is the universal and free healthcare system available for every Brazilian citizen.

SUS healthcare includes public hospitals, health centers and clinics. In order to access Brazil's public healtcare, an SUS card is needed.

How to apply for a SUS card

SUS cards are issued by all Brazilian health centers, free of charge. The following documents are required to obtain an SUS card:

- 1) Passport
- 2) Photocopy of CPF card
- 3) Proof of residence
