

RULES IN CASE OF EXAMS OVERLAPPING

Given that exchange students normally take classes from different academic years and different degrees, sometimes the exam dates and timetables for two subjects are the same. Of course, you can solve this complicated situation talking to your professors. Normally they are very open concerning this issue, but here you have the general rules on how to change exam dates, depending on the kind of subjects that have a “date conflict”:

1. In the case of conflict between two Core Curriculum courses corresponding to the same academic year, the one corresponding to the first semester will have priority. If both pertain to the same semester, the course assigned an earlier official examination date and time will have priority. Finally, if Core Curriculum courses corresponding to different academic years coincide, the one corresponding to the earlier year will have priority.
2. In the case of conflict between two Required courses from the same academic year, the course corresponding to the first semester will have priority. If both pertain to the same semester, the course assigned an earlier official examination date and time will have priority. Finally if the conflicting Required courses correspond to two different academic years, the one corresponding to the earlier year will have priority.
3. In the case of conflict between a Core Curriculum course and a Required course corresponding to the same academic year, the Core Curriculum course will have priority. If on the contrary, the courses pertain to different years, the earlier one will have priority, regardless of it being Core Curriculum or Required.
4. In the case of conflict between Core Curriculum and/or Required and/or Complementary Training courses with one or more Elective courses, the former will have priority, regardless of the academic year to which the courses correspond.
5. In the case of conflicts between Elective courses, the one corresponding to the earlier academic year will always have priority. If both Electives pertain to the same academic year, the one assigned an earlier official examination date and time will have priority.
