As you know, on-line teaching and telecommuting will cease between the 4th and 13th April, both days included. I also attach the President's Decision to suspend on-site teaching for the remainder of the 2019-20 academic year. The format of these on-line or on-site assessments will depend upon the health situation in which we find ourselves at that time.
