

Welcome to the School of Economics (SOE) and the Wang Yanan Institute for Studies in Economics (WISE) at Xiamen University. As one of the top centers for teaching and research on economics and finance in the country, SOE and WISE are privileged to welcome numerous domestic and international students and scholars each year.

Founded in 1921, the Department of Economics at XMU became China's first School of Economics in 1981. Ever since its establishment, the SOE has not only maintained its leading edge in economic research in China, but has also forged ahead towards its goal of being an internationally recognized center for teaching and research.

In 2005, economics research at Xiamen University received a huge boost with the establishment of the Wang Yanan Institute for Studies in Economics. WISE is a research-oriented institute founded as part of an initiative to modernize economics and finance research and education in China. WISE focuses on frontier research, high-quality teaching, and enjoys intensive international academic exchanges and cooperation. The SOE and WISE not only offer students rich courses on modern economics, econometrics and finance taught by distinguished faculty, but also provide innovative programs tailored to different career goals, excellent study abroad opportunities, sophisticated information technology services, and fascinating teaching and research experiences.

Currently, the SOE is composed of 5 departments and 3 research centers. In total, there are over 3,000 students in 11 undergraduate majors, 33 master's degree majors, and 22 doctoral degree majors. It is currently ranked among the top 5 schools of economics in China.







### **TOP RATE FACULTY**

Research and teaching are the two pillars of economics at Xiamen University and begin with our talented faculty. In recent years, a number of outstanding PhD graduates from prestigious universities abroad have further strengthened our research and teaching. The SOE currently has 177 full-time faculty members, of whom 62 are professors and 69 are associate professors. In addition, there are 61 doctoral advisors among the faculty. Likewise, WISE also has dozens of highly touted faculty members and distinguished professors. So far, WISE has about 40 full-time faculty members who received their PhD degrees from renowned universities overseas, and 5 distinguished adjunct professors from North American universities who visit and teach at WISE regularly each year.





### **Student Exchanges**

SOE/WISE aims to endow students with global perspectives. To this end, we have created various exchange student networks and maintain close and friendly relations with world-renowned educational institutions. Each year, dozens of undergraduate students study abroad for a summer, semester, or whole academic year. Likewise, as more international students realize the increasing importance of China, we are beginning to welcome various students on short-term, semester, or year-long exchanges.

### **Study Abroad Degree Options**

In 2010, the SOE cooperated with the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, University College Dublin, the University of Cincinnati and the University of Adelaide to establish new SOE Study Abroad Programs. For the very first time, students from the SOE were offered the chance to experience a western education during their undergraduate studies, obtaining double degrees from Xiamen University and our overseas partners. We are proud to say that these students have integrated into the local cultures in their host countries, excelling both within and outside of the classroom.



Xiamen University (XMU), originally founded in 1921 by the famous overseas Chinese patriot, Tan Kah Kee, is one of the best universities in China. There are nearly 40,000 students at the university, including over 2,000 international students. Xiamen University is not only famous for its academics and research, but it is also known as home to the most beautiful campus in China. Located just steps away from the beach, the campus is nestled against a mountain backdrop and boasts historic architecture.

Not only are we located in the beautiful city of Xiamen and on the scenic Xiamen University campus, but we also boast a new building opened in 2013 and high-tech classrooms and numerous study areas.

Our facilities include an experimental lab (FEEL—Finance and Economics Experimental Laboratory) as well as a Finance Lab. WIFI covers all classrooms and even the quaint courtyards, a favorite area for students to study or relax.

Students are also welcome to study in our economics library or enjoy a cup of coffee in our E-co Café.
