

STUDY ABROAD AND EXCHANGE Post-Offer FAQs

My offer is conditional, what does this mean?

If you have a conditional offer, this means that you have not met one of the conditions for entry yet. Read the conditions section of your offer of place carefully and ensure that you submit the required documentation before arriving at Victoria.

How do I know which courses I have been pre-approved for?

To see which of your selected courses have been sent for pre-approval, read the notes section of your offer of place. The notes section will state any courses that have not been sent for pre-approval and a reason why. If you have not selected enough available courses, it will ask you to resubmit a new selection of courses and the deadline to submit them by.

You will receive an email once all your course pre-approvals have been processed. The pre-approval takes between two and three weeks after the offer of place is received.

Where do I submit my courses for pre-approval?

You will have submitted these courses along with your application. If you need to submit additional courses, you can email your course selection to victoria-international@vuw.ac.nz

How many courses can I have pre-approved?

You can select a maximum of eight courses per trimester for pre-approval.

How many times can I submit courses for pre-approval?

You can only send your courses for pre-approval once. If you are not pre-approved for a full-time course load, you have the opportunity to resubmit additional courses.

Additional courses may be sent for pre-approval in exceptional circumstances.

How do I select my courses online?

Once you have been pre-approved into at least three courses and you have an unconditional offer, you will be invited to select your courses online. You must select pre-approved courses when enrolling online or your online enrolment will not be accepted.

I've selected my courses online, can I make changes?

You are not able to make changes to courses once you have selected them through the online system. You will be able to make changes to your courses with the relevant faculty once you have completed Orientation and Enrolment in person.

I've selected my courses online, how do I complete my enrolment?
