University of Kentucky Education Abroad and Exchanges

The University of Kentucky is the state's flagship, land-grant institution. Its mission is to provide education and research on behalf of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and the larger world around us. UK is a nationally ranked research university (meaning it is within the top 200 of the almost 5000 institutions of higher education across the USA) and all UK programs are ranked among the top 5% in the country. UK offers a wide range of research opportunities at undergraduate and graduate level working alongside nationally recognized faculty in state-of-the-art facilities. The \$112 million Don & Cathy Jacobs Science Building opened in fall 2016, just months after the Gatton College of Business and Economics moved into a new \$65 million building. While every college offers many highly rated areas of study, these are some highlights which may be of interest to students looking to attend UK on an exchange program.
