

**Visiting assistant professor (tenure-track) at Continuum Mechanics and Structural Analysis
Department , Universidad Carlos III de Madrid**

The Continuum Mechanics and Structural Analysis Department at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid (UC3M) invites applications for one full-time Visiting Assistant Professor position, starting on September 1st, 2022.

Job requirements include:

- An excellent track record of research experience in any of the topics of the Continuum Mechanics and Structural Analysis Department (Computational Mechanics, Biomechanics, Composite Structures, Solid Mechanics, and Additive Manufacturing), reflected in high-quality internationally refereed publications.
- A PhD in related fields by the expected start date.
- Experience in the participation of competitive research projects and technological transfer projects. The participation in European/International projects and recognition from European/international entities will be favourably evaluated.
- Demonstrated high-quality teaching experience and/or proven didactic skills.
- Excellent proficiency in English (written and verbal, as faculty are expected to teach courses in English, both at the undergraduate and graduate levels), providing a certificate or international experience of at least 2 years in English native country.
- Experience of research activity in prestigious foreign academic centres.

Conditions of employment include:

- For the Lecturer/Assistant Professor (tenure-track) position, a contract of 1 year in compliance with Spanish and University regulations. The salary corresponds to that of a Ayudante Doctor (24285,66 €/year) in public Spanish universities of Comunidad de Madrid.

Foreign applicants must have valid documentation to work in Spain prior to starting.
